Some bursary funds are also available through the Cheshunt Foundation if other sources of financial support cannot be found. We don't want anyone to be excluded purely on financial grounds.

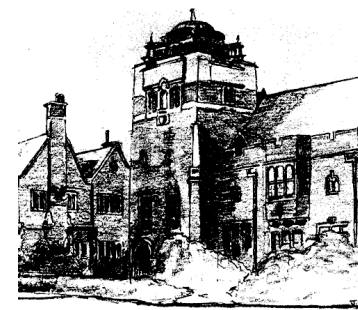
